Interview of Advocate Akbar Siddiqui, Supreme Court of India, published in Daily Inquilab on 24 August 2025. He achieved historic success by securing 1st position in the Delhi Higher Judicial Services Examination.

The results of the Delhi Higher Judicial Services Examination 2024 were announced on 20 August 2025. In which **Akbar Siddiqui secured 712 marks out of a 1000 marks** & secured the first position in the merit list. It is noteworthy that he is the first member of his family to take up the profession of lawyer & then obtained a high position in the judicial service on the basis of his professional expertise in this field. Akbar Siddiqui's father was associated with the civil engineering department in the government services & is currently retired.



Akbar Siddiqui is known for his excellent advocacy and legal expertise in the Supreme Court. His role was especially important in the Satyendra Kumar case,in which he gave a new direction to the thinking of the Indian judiciary regarding bail.

I will, InshaAllah, abide by the laws while holding my position & ensure justice for every section of the society Although Akbar Siddiqui's hometown is Ambedkar Nagar district Akbarpur of UP, he was born, brought up & educated in Delhi. He said that I starts my primary education from St.Michael's Senior Secondary School, Delhi. Later,for higher education, I took admission in Aligarh Muslim University, from there I obtained a law degree in 2007.

Regarding the preparation for Judicial Services, Agnir Siddiqui said since I have been practicing in the field of law since 2008, I had been associated with the profession of law for almost the last 17 years, so I got the self inspiration to from there only. I have a lots of experience in the field of law & have a good knowledge of the law, besides, I had also joined a coaching institute in the meantime, which I left later. The real secret of my success is my self-study. I have made constant hard work & on the basis of that I have achieved this remarkable success. I am the only one in my family, most of the people are in engineering & medical fields or in private jobs.

Commenting on his success, Akbar Siddiqui said The biggest role in my success is played by my parents, my wife, teachers & the educational environment of AMU. AMU has always been producing the best legal minds for the country.

In his message to the youth, he said, Step towards the destination with hard work, honesty, dedication, prepare for this exam with a good purpose & intentions. If I can reach this point, it is also possible for you. Hard work is the real key to success.

Notification: Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE 2026)

The Indian Institute of Technology Guwahati has announced the Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE) 2026. The examination will be conducted under the National Coordination Board (GATE), Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education.

Key Details:

- Organizing Institute: IIT Guwahati
- Application Process: Online registration begins on 25 August 2025 and closes on 25 September 2025 (without late fee). Applications with late fee will be accepted until 6 October 2025.
- **Examination Dates:** The test will be conducted on 7, 8, 14 and 15 February 2026, in computer-based mode across multiple cities, with two sessions per day.
- **Subjects Offered:** A total of 30 papers covering Engineering, Technology, Science, Commerce, Arts, Architecture and Humanities.

Candidates who qualify in GATE become eligible to seek admission, with possible financial assistance, to Master's programs, Direct Doctoral programs, and Doctoral programs in relevant branches of Engineering, Technology, Science, Architecture, and Humanities at IITs and other institutions supported by the Ministry of Education and other Government agencies. GATE scores are also considered by several institutions for admission to postgraduate programs without MoE scholarships. In addition, many leading Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) use GATE scores for recruitment purposes.

Candidates aspiring for higher studies and opportunities in public sector undertakings are advised to carefully read the information brochure and complete the registration process within the given timelines.



Eligibility:

- For UG (LL.B. Integrated Programmes):
 - Must have completed or be appearing in Class 12 (or equivalent) in 2026.
 - Minimum marks: 45% (40% for SC/ST/PwD).
 - O No upper age limit.
- For PG (LL.M. Programmes):
 - Must have completed or be in the final year of LL.B. degree.
 - Minimum marks: 50% (45% for SC/ST/PwD).

- 3. Select your preferred exam centres.
- 4. Upload scanned copies of your photograph, signature, and category certificate (if applicable).

 - O SC/ST/BPL: **₹3,500**
 - O Previous years' question papers (optional add-on): ₹500
- 6. Submit the form and keep a copy of the confirmation page.


